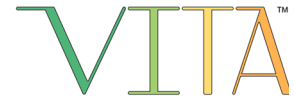
If you live in Racine County, you may qualify for VITA.

What do I bring?

- Current photo identification (driver's license, state ID or student ID).
- Social security cards or ITINs for you, your spouse (if married), and any dependents you are claiming.
- All wage and tax statements, including:
 - W-2
 - W-2G
 - 1099-R
 - 1099-G
 - SSA-1099
 - 1099-INT
 - 1099-DIV
- Any other tax documents you've received.
- Bank routing and account number for direct deposit.
- If you are not sure if VITA needs it, bring it along.
- Homestead credit is available to Wisconsin residents with an income under \$24,680. Bring your property tax bill or rent certificate and SSI or Wisconsin Works payment documents for the year you are filing.
- If married filing jointly, you can file electronically only if you and your spouse are both present to sign.

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
