PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Outpatient Mental Health Therapist

Provide comprehensive counseling and case management services to individuals presenting with mental health diagnoses, who may also present with AODA issues.

- Provide assessment and document bio-psycho-social intake
- Engage patient in treatment
- Prepare initial treatment plans; 90-day reviews
- Provide therapy to individuals, based on treatment goals
- Provide group therapy
- Provide treatment in compliance with DHS 35
- Participate in professional staffing as required by license
- Provide psychological testing, as allowed by license
- Participate in continuous program quality improvement efforts

Must be licensed in Wisconsin as Psychologist, and be able to practice without restriction.

Must have professional liability insurance \$1/\$3 million coverage

Must pass Wisconsin criminal and caregiver background check

Must have a professional experience or desire to provide services to the uninsured and underinsured.

Must have professional experience providing services to those with mental illness.
