Deputy Director Danculovich explained that the Human Services Department applied for and won a Youth Innovation grant in the amount of \$250,000. She said the money will be used for a Credible Messenger Program and described the program.

## **Resolution by the Health and Human Development Committee Authorizing the Human Services Department to Enter into a Contract with Manpower Group for Retained Advisory Services and the Transfer of \$135,000.00 from the Health Services 2018 Budget to the Human Services 2018 Budget**

County Executive Delagrave introduced Kristin Latus who will take the lead on this project. County Executive Delagrave provided background and said the \$135,000 transfer starts the process with Ms. Latus spearheading the marketing campaign for individuals to move here and fill jobs.

Ms. Latus gave an overview of what the \$135,000 will be used for. Director Otto and Ms. Latus have been engaging with Manpower to design a program specific for Racine County, they're calling it "Do It With Us" to help us create a workforce strategy specific to talent recruitment and what that would look like over a three year horizon. Manpower will work alongside of us over the next 12-18 months to develop the strategy which will include a marketing and workforce strategies to open Racine County to bring people into this area from other states and other regions. When we're ready, they'll move on and we'll be left with a beautiful plan to bring people in for the next several years.

County Executive Delagrave explained why Racine County is getting into the talent recruitment business. He said this will take a partnership with businesses to work with our website GreaterRacineCounty.com and talk about our school districts, our parks, our 17 municipalities and what they have to offer, etc. Racine County is doing this because we need to market for Racine County while business will only market for their own jobs. Businesses will be asked if they want to participate and be a part of the process, either contribute or donate, or both to be part of the solution as well because they have the most to gain in talent recruitment.

Discussion ensued.

Sup. Miller moved to send the Resolution to County Board for first reading November 5, 2018. Sup. Nielsen seconded.
