- Three small buildings with electricity: 50 person / building capacity
- Grills, picnic tables, and drinking water
- Flush toilets

Root River Parkway

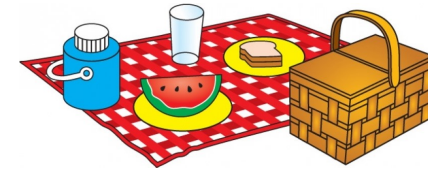
- Located at 3630 Rapids Court, Racine WI

Reservable Picnic Facilities

General Rules and Regulations:

- Picnic season is the first weekend in May through the last weekend in September
- **Reservations will be accepted in person or by mail beginning the second business day of January of the given calendar year. ONLINE PICNIC RESERVATIONS - go to <http://racinecounty.com/government/public-works-and-development-services/parks> (scroll down and click on link)**
- **Reservation requests by phone will be accepted on the second Monday in January of the given calendar year**
- Picnic areas are available on a first come - first serve basis when an advance reservation is not in place
- No reservation will be made without payment in full
- Park hours are posted at each park
- Park only in designated areas
- No alcoholic beverages allowed in park - beer is allowed by permit only
- Dogs are not allowed in parks (excluding dog parks, campgrounds, and bike trail designated areas)
- Glass containers are not permitted

Bushnell Park

- Located at 32100 Bushnell Road, Burlington WI
- Size: 95 acres
- Shelter with electricity: 150 person capacity
- Flush toilets
- Baseball fields, soccer fields, and horseshoe pits
- Children's playground

Cliffside Park

- Located at 7320 Michna Road, Racine WI
- Size: 233 acres
- Two shelters with electricity: 75 person / shelter capacity
 - Shelter 1 has restrooms attached
- One Open Picnic Area: 50 person capacity
- Grills, picnic tables, and drinking water
- Flush toilets
- Four baseball fields, soccer fields, & basketball court
- Children's playground

Quarry Lake Building

- Located at 3533 Northwestern Avenue, Racine WI
- Size: 40 acres
- Enclosed building with electricity and kitchen
- Inside and outside seating: 100 person capacity; 75 inside
- Grills, picnic tables and drinking water
- Flush toilets and showers
- Sand volleyball court

Eagle Lake Park

- Located at 23705 Church Road, Kansasville WI
- Size: 25 acres
- Shelter with electricity: 150 person capacity
- One Open Picnic Area: 75 person capacity
- Grills, picnic tables and drinking water
- Flush toilets
- Baseball fields, sand volleyball court, and horseshoe pits
- Boat launch
- Children's playground

Colonial Heg Park

- Located at 6300 Heg Park Road, Waterford WI
- Size: 20 acres
- North Shelter with electricity: 100 person capacity
- South Shelter with electricity: 150 person capacity
- One Open Picnic Area: 50 person capacity
- Grills, picnic tables, and drinking water
- Flush toilets
- Historic museum, log cabin, & rectory with curator available 12-4 p.m. during summer weekends and holidays
- Baseball fields and horseshoe pits
- Children's playground

Pritchard Park

- Located at 2800 Ohio Street, Racine WI
- Size: 79 acres
- South Shelter with electricity: 150 person capacity
- Wieczorek Pavilion with electricity: 250 person capacity
- Two Open Picnic Area: 50 person / area capacity
- Grills, tables, and drinking water
- Flush toilets
- Veterans Memorial
- Baseball fields, football / soccer fields, sand volleyball court
- Children's playground

Sanders Park

- Located at 4809 Wood Road, Racine WI
- Size: 80 acres
- Shelter with electricity : 100 person capacity
- Two Open Picnic Areas: 50 person / area capacity
- One (large) Open Picnic Area: 75 person capacity
