

Who can claim this credit?

- **You may claim** – this credit if you transfer a home after the January 1, 2020 certification date; it may qualify for the Lottery and Gaming Credit if the property was used by the previous owner as a primary residence on January 1, 2020.
- **You cannot claim this credit if the home was:**
 - Not the primary residence of the previous owner on January 1, 2020
 - Used as rental property on January 1, 2020
 - Unoccupied on January 1, 2020
